

marked the 25th Anniversary of Child Advocates of Fort Bend serving children who have been abused or neglected.

We have Provided a Voice, Healed the Hurt and Broken the Cycle of abuse for more than 14,000 children and these numbers are growing every year. In 2016, we reached 11% more children from the prior year – by expanding existing programs, adding new services, and piloting new initiatives to reach every CHILD with every SERVICE by every EFFORT. Over the 25 years, we have heard story after story of tragedy and heartbreak. But most importantly, through the work of a dedicated multi-disciplinary team of board, volunteers, staff, partners, and donors, we have built a comprehensive agency and a coordinated public-private response to the tragedy of child abuse – and in so doing, turned heartbreak into triumph and resiliency. Let me share with you how we are doing just that.

Provide a Voice

We were delighted to swear in our 1000th CASA Volunteer in 2016! Volunteers form the core of service delivery in our CASA Program and help us leverage limited staff and financial resources to match 100% of children in foster care in Fort Bend County with a trained CASA Volunteer – an accomplishment that very few programs across the country have achieved. By contrast, in the state of Texas, only 56% of children in foster care have a CASA. We are so pleased that our community has repeatedly stepped up to ensure that no child falls through the cracks.

We introduced an initiative which connects children to extended family members who may have formerly been unknown to them to create a support system while they are in the care of the child welfare system and beyond. Termed Collaborative Family Engagement, we have already connected 17 youth with supportive adults, restored their familial identities and, for one child, located a family member who helped his doctors diagnose and treat a life-threatening genetic condition.

In our Children's Advocacy Center, we launched a new statewide initiative in which we review all state reports of child abuse to supplement the work being done by CPS and law enforcement and ensure that no child goes without services. In our first year, we referred 395 children to our Center - for forensic interviews, medical exams and therapy - children who might otherwise have fallen through the cracks and gone without help.

We were also selected by the state of Texas to introduce a new initiative to reach out to foster children from other counties who are placed far away from their homes and may not have regular visits by their CASA Volunteers. Our Courtesy CASA Coordinator covered 33 cities in the Eastern and Coastal Regions, daily visiting children in their placements to ensure their "best interests" were being met.

Heal the Hurt

For young children struggling with severe antisocial behavior as a result of trauma from their abuse, we introduced *Parent Child Interaction Therapy* (PCIT) for traumatized children in our CAC. Working with a team at University of California Davis Medical School, our staff were trained and certified, video cameras were installed and earbuds were purchased to coach parents while they interacted with their children. The outcomes have been remarkable as we witnessed children who had severe behavioral issues transform over a few months into calm, responsive children whose parents regained their control and emotional connection with them. We will be expanding this program in the coming year.

Break the Cycle

In WINGS, the program we developed 11 years ago to help foster youth who "age out" of the child welfare system be successful, 100% of our high school seniors graduated from high school, a huge accomplishment from the early days when only 25% of our foster youth graduated! And for the first time, we celebrated our first college graduate!

2016 also recognized the incredible accomplishments achieved 25 years later by our very first child we served in our CASA Program, 6-year-old Larry. This young boy suffered abuse by his mother, was removed and placed in 4 different foster homes and was headed to the 5th in less than 3 months. Fortunately, Larry was Larry then . . . and now one of the lucky ones - he had a CASA Volunteer to advocate for his "best interests". Today, Larry has broken the cycle. After 12 years in the foster care system, Larry went on to fulfill his goals – attended college, is successfully employed and has a wonderful family with two beautiful boys.

Our Challenges

As the demand for services grows, we struggle to have enough staff, resources and space to help all the children who are victims of abuse. Currently, 109 children sit on our therapy waitlist because we don't have enough therapists. Staff is doubled-up in offices as we outgrow our building. And increased state intakes of abuse translate to even more pressure on all our services to ensure no child falls through the cracks.

Our commitment is that we do everything in our power to never turn a child away. Thank you for your continuing support.








15% Physical Abuse



Her career ambition is to work with children in foster care who are facing unsurmountable obstacles, just like she did. She wants to show them that they can overcome and succeed. In a presentation she made at the state CASA Conference, she credits much of her success to having her CASA Volunteer advocate for her during these tough years.

Child Advocates of Fort Bend gives kids like Jackie more than a glimmer of hope. It provides them a fighting chance. And it is working. Thank you to those who stand by thousands of children like Jackie every day by making it possible for their hopes and dreams to come true.
