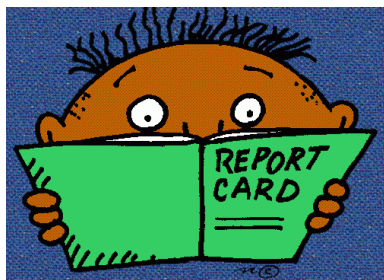





Education Resources
